- Materials that are CCA (Perma Pine) treated or MDF

There are no additional cost for unloading tray-top trucks as long as they are stacked in a manner that allows accessibility to do so.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Como Wood Supply:

ABN: 70603344396 - Registered office, 23 – 27, Wilkins Road, Gillman, 5013, Adelaide, South Australia. **Environmental Licence number 47522. These Terms and Conditions also includes such subsidiary companies of Como Wood Supply “Adelaide Pallet Recycling” and “Adelaide Mulch Supplies”** and may participate in the performance of a contract or written agreement.

2. CONTRACT:

(a) These conditions together with any specification, provided by Como Wood Supply in connection with the acceptance, supply or processing of goods or materials (“the Services”) and any attached order shall constitute the contract, agreement or order documents for the entire terms of this agreement.

3. “General Scope of Service”:

(a) Removal of Waste by client/contractor or Como Wood Supply for any unwanted materials and or subsequent treatment, disposal, processing or recovery as specified in the full terms and conditions by Como Wood Supply.

(b) Times and Dates quoted by Como Wood Supply for undertaking these Services are intended as estimates only and will not be of the essence of the Contract in this respect unless agreed to in writing attached to this document.

(c) The client or contractor is to supply goods or materials to Como Wood Supply and nominated sizes, quantities and types of goods and materials acceptable (from time to time) to Como Wood Supply.

(d) Supply of any equipment (example) machinery or trucks etc. for use by the client or Como Wood Supply as part of the services in (3) above

(e) Ensure that the Materials delivered comply with the quality size and nature specified in any order or agreement attached to this document.

(f) The client or contractor is to supply materials or goods for the amount or at the rates of charge referred to by Como Wood Supply in the attached order or agreement.

(g) Processing includes the loading/un loading operations associated with (clause 3) above, transport, decontamination and any other handling operation associated with (clause 3) above.

(h) Notwithstanding any other provision of these terms and conditions, Como Wood Supply may at any time at its absolute discretion stop receiving waste products and or stop providing the Services and shall not be responsible in any way for any losses damages, costs of any nature whatsoever that result from Como Wood Supply exercising this discretion.

4. Quality “Waste Materials”:

(a) The quality of the Materials delivered shall not differ from that specified in the Contract/order/agreement documents unless the change in quality is ordered by Como Wood Supply in a written form specifically referring to the amendment of the quality.

(b) Como Wood Supply may require, as a condition of delivery of any element of the Materials, the Client or Contractor must supply a sample of the relevant Materials for approval by Como Wood Supply. In the event that such a sample is produced and approved then any delivery of that element of the Materials which is referable to the sample shall be of a size and nature and quality consistent with that of the approved sample.

(c) Como Wood Supply does not accept “Hazardous” waste, materials or goods.

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(d) Como Wood Supply will accept specific contaminated goods; however, a contamination processing fee will apply (to be advised at the time). Contaminated goods will only be accepted upon written approval and agreement associated with (clause 3) & (clause 5).

5. Statutory Requirements, Licences, Permits and Approvals:

(a) Como Wood Supply is an approved EPA license holder (EPA number 47522) issued by the Environmental Protection Authority in South Australia and is subject to strict prescribed activities of environmental significance. These conditions include (waste recycling for resource recovery or transfer). The contractor or client agrees to comply with The Environmental Protection Act 1993 and the Environmental Protection Regulations 2009.

(b) The Contractor or client shall ensure that it complies with clause (clause 4) and (clause 5a) for the supply and delivery of the Materials satisfies all of the requirements of all relevant laws, Acts of Parliament and all ordinances, regulations, by-laws, orders and proclamations made or issued there under applicable to the sale, supply or delivery of the Materials and, where necessary, secure all necessary approvals/permits and pay all fees incurred in connection with the sale supply or delivery thereof to Como Wood Supply. This includes compliance with Australian Standards (if applicable).

6. Delivery and or Freight

(a) Delivery shall be made to such locations and at such time as shall be nominated by the Como Wood Supply.

(b) Upon delivery the Materials shall be accompanied by delivery documentation approved by Como Wood Supply. Delivery documentation shall state clearly the contents of the materials or goods.

(c) Como Wood Supply shall only be obligated to accept delivery of such Materials as to comply with this document (subject to 4.d and 3(h)).

(d) If the delivery of Materials does not comply with Como Wood Supply Terms and Conditions the client or contractor, if so required by Como Wood Supply will remove all such rejected elements of the Materials and replace the same with a delivery of the Materials acceptable to the Como Wood Supply. All freight, insurance and other charges whatsoever in connection with the return of that element of the Materials wrongly supplied and the delivery of a further supply of the Materials shall be paid and borne by the Client or Contractor.

(e) In the event of a suitable, safe access point from which to collect the waste not being available, then Como Wood Supply reserve the right to refuse the collection. In the event that the lack of a suitable, safe access point requires waste to be transported through the premises then Como Wood Supply shall not be liable for any damage caused by the operation of transporting the waste to a suitable, safe access point.

(f) The Client or Contractor shall be liable to pay demurrage for unreasonable detention of any vehicle or trailer at the clients or contractors site at the current Como Wood Supply demurrage rates, unless otherwise agreed in writing. Unreasonable detention or waiting time at the clients or contractor's premises, or further premises and sites nominated by the client or contractor shall incur hourly demurrage costs.

7. Payment

(a) The client will pay Como Wood Supply the charges for the services as indicated on the Contract or agreement. Como Wood Supply charge rates are subject to variation (unless a specific term is agreed to in writing).

(b) All sums due are payable within 30 days of the date of the relevant invoice.

(c) Unless agreed otherwise in writing, all prices quoted to the Client or Contractor are exclusive of GST, or any similar tax levied by the Government on the value of services. This shall be added to the invoice and paid by the Client.

(c) If the client fails to make any payment that is due, Como Wood Supply reserves the right to suspend the provision of any service.

8. Insurance

(a) The Client or contractor shall hold harmless and indemnify Como Wood Supply, its directors, officers and employees in respect of any loss or damage, claims, costs, liabilities and expenses arising from any breach of the Client's obligations under the Terms and Conditions or of a breach of legal requirements by the client or contractor.

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- (b) The Client must maintain (and effect if not already in force), insurance cover in an adequate amount to cover risk of, loss of or damage to Como Wood Supply property or the Client's property including other persons at the Client's or contractors Site including machinery, motor vehicles and other plant and equipment which may be operated or handled by any Como Wood Supply contractors or employees when undertaking Work.
- (c) The Client or contractor must maintain insurance cover in an adequate amount to cover the risk of death or personal injury of Client Employees or Contractor Employees, Como Wood Supply Employees or any other person caused or contributed to by any act or omission of the Client or contractor, its employees, agents or contractors.

9. CONDITIONS

(a) No variations or alterations of these conditions shall be binding on Como Wood Supply unless agreed in writing by, or on behalf of, Como Wood Supply by an authorised representative. All orders, goods or materials supplied by the Client or contractor for the Services shall be deemed to be an offer by the Client to purchase the Services pursuant to these conditions.

(b) Performance of the Services by Como Wood Supply shall be deemed conclusive evidence of the Client's acceptance of these Conditions. These conditions shall remain in force until such time as Como Wood Supply adopts revised conditions and notifies the client of the substitution of these conditions by the revised conditions.
